Nice balance of sweetness and tart, with hints of banana and clove.

Perfectly balanced with rich malts and citrusy hops. Yummy Yummy!			
Kasteel Framboise	Inglemunster, Belgium	4.5%	10oz. Flute \$7
Raspberry flavor is dominant in this unique, classic Belgian frambozen ale.			
Great Lakes Edmund Fitzgerald Porter	Ohio	5.8%	Pint \$6
