

## ***The Reef Wine List***

### **Great Whites**

***Simi Chardonnay, Sonoma: 2003*** 10.00 30.00

*Partially barrel fermented, all are barrel aged in French oak, it's a perfect balance of textures and flavors. Its fruit flavors are vibrant with notes of citrus, spice, and vanillia.*

***Estancia Pinnacles Chardonnay, Monterey: 2003*** 8.00 26.00

*The cool Monterey climate accompanied by a long growing season produces a ripe mouth filling Chardonnay. A rich fruity bouquet and soft creamy texture of this Chardonnay result from combining the best attributes of barrel and tank fermentation. Subtle oak accentuates bright fruit.*

***Horton Viognier, Orange Virginia: 2002*** 10.00 32.00

*A bold, spicy, aromatic wine with intense peach and vanilla flavors*

***Kenwood Sauvignon Blanc, Sonoma 2004*** 7.00 21.00

*This wine is pleasantly fruity with delicious peach, citrus, and melon flavors, a hint of vanilla and hazelnut, and a touch of grass complimenting the wines smooth, creamy finish.*

***Twin Fin Pinot Grigio, Central Coast: 2004*** 7.00 24.00

*This Californian Pinot Grigio is crisp with a bit of a bite to liven up any occasion, it features aromas of rose petal and spicy citrus.*

***Dry Creek Fumet Blanc, Sonoma: 2003*** 9.00 26.00

*The cornerstone of Dry Creek vineyard. Brisk but balanced flavors of lemon-lime are charged with tropical fruit and bright acid, continuing into a long, memorable finish.*

***Mosselland Arsvitis Riesling, Germany: 2003*** 8.00 24.00

*Medium sweet with hints of exotic fruit and a crisp, refreshing finish*

***Snoqualmie Chennin Blanc, Columbia Valley: 2002*** 6.00 22.00

*The nose exhibits aromas of lemon and pear with hints of anise. These flavors follow on the pallet with a cleansing bright finish.*

## Red Wines

**Robert Mondavi Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa 2001**      **1/2Bottle 15.00**

*A delicious Napa Valley Cabernet boasting notes of chocolate and cherry.*

*This wine great for sipping and with red meats.*

**Los Vascos Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile: 2003**      **8.00    28.00**

*It is an attractive ruby color and has a red fruit nose, with chocolate and bay leaf touches. This wine is pleasant, excellent bodied, juicy and ripe.*

*Highly concentrated with strawberry and cherry fruit notes and marked spices*

**Shale Ridge Merlot, Monterey: 2004**      **8.00    26.00**

*Fresh and vibrant aromas of red plums, Bing cherries and currant*

*Abound in the aroma while the flavor is nicely complimented by*

*French Oak. Soft tannins and acidity lend themselves to an easy*

*Drinking style of merlot.*

**Cross Point Pinot Noir, Monterey: 2005**      **9.00    28.00**

*Characterized by aromas of cherry jam, rhubarb and stewed strawberries*

*with a faint touch of sage underbrush spiciness. A soft, fruit flavored,*

*spicy wine with layers of complexity*

**McWilliams Shiraz, Australia: 2003**      **7.00    24.00**

*Lifted blackberry, plum and shiraz spiced aromas with cinnamon and*

*vanilla oak characters. Fine tannins provide the wine with a solid*

*backbone complimented by a long, fresh finish.*

**Ravenswood Lodi Zinfandel, 2002**      **9.00    30.00**

*Thick and rich concentrated blueberry fruit and soft spice as well as a*

*bright, lively berry flavors hinting at raspberry. French oak barrels have*

*rounded and fattened the wine while contributing notes of vanilla and subtle spice.*
